April 12, 2016

The Alcona Township regular board meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Roll call: Present: Supervisor Marlena MacNeill, Clerk Dawn LaLonde, Treasurer Tina Gauthier, & Trustees Jim Bouchard and Jim Mead.

Motion by Gauthier, seconded by Bouchard, to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. PASSED All in Favor.

Motion by LaLonde, seconded by Mead, to accept the treasurer's report as presented. PASSED All in Favor.

Motion by Mead, seconded by Bouchard, to pay bills as presented. PASSED All in Favor. Fire report, zoning report, and assessor report were received and filed.

Motion by Mead, seconded by Gauthier, to advertise for bids for a new fence near the Black River Ball Park and for bathroom renovations at the Alcona Township Hall. PASSED All in Favor.

Motion by Gauthier, seconded by Bouchard, to reimburse Walter Unkovich for dust control he paid for on behalf of property owners in Woodhaven Subdivision based on the contract with C & S Dust Control. PASSED All in Favor This was for the 2015 season which allows \$80.00 maximum per property owner for 100 feet.

Motion by Mead, seconded by Gauthier, to renew the contract with C & S Dust Control. PASSED All in Favor. The township will reimburse the property owner 100% of the first application of 100 feet. Maximum of \$80.00 per property owner.

County Commissioner Kathy Vichunas announced that she is running for re-election and asked for the boards support.

On April 28, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. the planning commission will meet at the harbor to look over potential projects that could be done to enhance the harbor/beach area. The public is invited to attend and give their input.
