Tim Lee, Alcona Elementary Principal spoke to all regarding the upcoming school millage proposals on the August ballot.

The Pavilion repairs are on hold until the lake level stabilizes.

Fire Report was received; topic of training costs being shared was discussed again with the possibility of having an agreement in place between other fire departments before training is approved.

Zoning Administrator, Tammy Mendyka, reported that she has been busy writing Land Use Permits and is also handling some nuisance complaints. She had contacted Attorney Wilson concerning a zoning violation and now that the Covid-19 restrictions have been lifted she will touch base with him again to see if he was able to follow up with the issue.
