Discussion took place concerning residents asking for more than one zoning variance. The zoning board of appeals only grants a variance when the property owner can show a hardship. The planning commission feels the ordinance in place is written properly.

The assessors, zoning administrators, and fire reports were received and filed.

Motion by LaLonde, seconded by Gauthier, to approve LLWC fire works for July 4th. PASSED All in Favor.

Supervisor MacNeill will contact the Alcona Road Commission and have them draft an agreement for Woodland, Lake and Hubbard Street.

The DNR has started dredging the Black River.

County Commissioner, Dan Gauthier, reported the court house is open to the public once again. The commissioners are waiting for clarification as to what the stimulus money can be spent on.

Supervisor MacNeill will order five new signs. Two directional signs for the Alcona Township Park and three for East Bay Access Site.

Treasurer Gauthier is working with LakeShore Broadband to provide internet to her home as well as the clerk's home. She will keep the board informed.

Residents on Ridge Road questioned a possible zoning violation on their road. Supervisor MacNeill will follow up with the Zoning Administrator concerning this.
